Information about the 1st credit test in Pathological Physiology 1

Test organization

The credit test consists of two parts:

- Multiple-choice test ROGO (electronic format)
 - o Conducted during the first half of the lecture
 - Scope and duration:
 - VL group: 25 questions 50 minutes
 - ZL group: 20 questions 40 minutes
 - Each question contains 5 statements with a variable ratio of correct and incorrect ones.
 Students must mark YES or NO for each statement, depending on whether it is correct or incorrect.
 - Each correctly marked answer is worth 1 point. To pass, a student must achieve at least 60%.
 - GM: max. 125 points min. (60%) 75 points
 - DM: max. 100 points min. (60%) 60 points

2. Open test (written part)

- Paper format
- o Conducted during the second half of the lecture
- o Duration: 40 minutes
- Students either fill in or circle the correct answers, depending on the specific formulations of each question
- o The scoring of each question depends on its scope and difficulty
- To pass, a student must achieve at least 60%
- Students must first complete the ROGO test and may proceed to the open test only after finishing the ROGO test. The ROGO test will automatically close when time expires, and it will not be possible to return to it.
- The results of the ROGO test will be published in AIS. Students will be informed about the open test results by their teacher.
