

# Information about the 3<sup>rd</sup> credit test in Pathological Physiology 2

## Date and venue

- **GM – Thursday, March 26, 2026, 8:00 - 10:30** in the **Aula** (note: lecture/test moved to the Aula!)
- **DM – Friday, March 27, 2026, 12:00 - 13:30** in **P4**

## Test organization

The credit test consists of two parts:

- **Multiple-choice test - ROGO** (electronic format)
  - Conducted during the first half of the lecture
  - Scope and duration:
    - GM: 30 questions – 60 minutes
    - DM: 25 questions – 50 minutes
  - Each question contains 5 statements with a variable ratio of correct and incorrect ones. Students must mark YES or NO for each statement, depending on whether it is correct or incorrect.
  - Each correctly marked answer is worth 1 point. To pass, a student must achieve at least 60%.
    - GM: max. 150 points – min. (60%) 90 points
    - DM: max. 125 points – min. (60%) 75 points
- **2. Open test** (written part)
  - Paper format
  - Conducted during the second half of the lecture
  - Duration: 40 minutes
  - Students either fill in or circle the correct answers, depending on the specific formulations of each question
  - The scoring of each question depends on its scope and difficulty
  - To pass, a student must achieve at least 60%
- **Students must first complete the ROGO test and may proceed to the open test only after finishing the ROGO test.** The ROGO test will automatically close when time expires, and it will not be possible to return to it.
- The results of the ROGO test will be published in AIS. Students will be informed about the open test results by their teacher.
